

## ORNAMENTAL TREES

### **PINK FLOWERING CRAB(SPIRES) 2" \$219 2.5" \$269**

Deep pink buds opening to pink flowers. Beautiful maroon fall colors. Grows to 25 feet.

### **DARK PINK CRAB "PRAIRIE FIRE" 2" \$219 2.5" \$269**

Dark pink buds opening to dark pink flowers. Grows to 25 feet.

### **WHITE FLOWERING CRAB 2" \$219 2.5" \$269**

One of the longest flowering crab trees. New leaves are a brilliant gold in color. Grows to 25 feet.

### **RED SPLENDOR FLOWERING CRAB 2" \$219 2.5" \$269**

Red buds opening to a rich red flower. Grows to 25 feet.

### **NEWPORT PURPLE PLUM 2" 229 2.5" \$269**

Gorgeous color ornamental tree. Upright spreading, pink flower in the spring. Blood red leaves in summer. Grows to 20 feet.

### **BRADFORD FLOWERING PEAR 2" \$259 2.5" \$319**

Loaded with white flowers in early spring. Produces crablike sized fruit. Goldish green leaf Turning to spectacular colors of red, purple, orange and scarlet color in late fall. Fast growing to 35 feet when mature.

### **MONTMORENCY CHERRY 2" \$249 2.5" \$325(no parkwy)**

Good, dense round habit. Rich yellow, orange and red fall color. White flowers in Spring with edible bright red fruit. Tolerates some shade. Grows up to 20 ft.

### **RIVER BIRCH 8' \$269 10' \$329 12' \$379 14' \$499**

Available in tree or multi-trunked form, is known for highly ornamental exfoliating bark With creamy white and pinkish tan patches. Green triangular leaves turning yellow in fall. Fast growing to 40-50 feet.

### **JAPANESE WHITE BIRCH \$269 6FT \$349 8FT \$399 10FT**

**BLACK ALDER (CLUMP) \$219 6-7FT \$269 8-10FT \$299 10FT(no parkway)**

### **MERIL MAGNOLIA 6' \$199 8' \$229 (no parkway)**

The Village of Evergreen Park is pleased to announce its' bi-annual tree planting program for the spring, 2011. This program enables residents and business owners alike to choose from a great variety of trees at a low cost. Trees can be purchased for parkways, private property, or parks. Planting will be done by a Village approved nursery. Cost includes planting, mulch, root hormone, and a one year, one time, 100% free replacement guarantee. Trees to be planted are locally grown and are from quality nursery stock.

For residents wishing to have a tree removed from the parkway and intend on replacing a tree through this program, please visit the Village Hall and fill out the proper work order (homeowner signature required). A \$100 non-refundable deposit which will be applied to the purchase of a new tree will be required. All tree removal requests will be presented to our on staff licensed arborist who will assess the trees health and condition to determine whether or not it can be removed.

All tree orders must be submitted by April 1, 2011. Tree removal requests must be submitted by March 18, 2011. Question? Call Mary at 229-8219.

## TREES

The height may vary on all varieties of trees.  
(3" caliper & 3.5" caliper are available for the parkway)

### **PIN OAK 2" \$289 2.5" \$319 3" \$449**

Fast growing pyramidal with horizontal branching. Popular street tree. Dark green leaf in summer, turning yellow to coppery red in autumn. Produces acorns. Grows 60 x 35 feet.

### **NORTHERN RED OAK 2" \$299 2.5" \$329 3" \$459**

Fast growing, upright rounded with horizontal branching. Shallowly lobed sharp-pointed leaves unfold pinkish red, mature to dark green with gray-green undersides, turn russet-red to bright red in fall. Produces acorns. Grows 60 to 70 feet tall and wide.

### **SWAMP WHITE OAK 2" \$299 2.5" \$329 3" \$459**

This mighty oak is rugged and course, with a round, low, open canopy. Foliage is shiny dark green on top with velvety gray-green undersides that turn yellow-brown in autumn. Produces acorns. Grows 50 to 60 feet tall and spreads even wider.

### **KENTUCKY COFFEE TREE 2" \$319 2.5" \$379**

Height 70' Spread 40'-50' Growth: Moderate Leaf oval, irregular Flower White panicles Fruit: red-brown, 5" - 10' pod Foliage: dark green in summer and then bright yellow in fall

### **TULIP TREE 2" \$319 2.5" \$399 3" \$489**

Fast growing height 18 to 32 m flowers similar to a tulip in shape.

### **GINKGO AUTUMN GOLD 2" \$349 2.5" \$399 3" \$459**

Fast growing, good parkway tree. Male variety seedless, fan shaped leaf height 70'

### **Marmo Maple (New) 2" \$329 2.5" \$379**

Height : 60'-80' Spread: 35' - 40" Growth: medium-fast Leaf: oval, vase-shaped Flower: yellow-red Foliage: green in Summer and scarlet-maroon in Fall.

### **RED CRIMSOM MAPLE 2" \$419 2.5" \$519**

a/k/a Crimson King. Used mostly as an ornamental, brilliant red color retained throughout The summer. Grows up to 50ft.

### **RED SUNSET MAPLE 2" \$329 2.5" 379 3" 459**

The greatest of the red maples. Medium-sized, glossy green leaf turning brilliant red in fall. Upright branches. Grows to 45 feet.

### **AUTUMN BLAZE MAPLE 2" \$319 2.5" 359 3" 459**

Related to Red Maple but a faster growing maple. Green leaves turning brilliant red in fall. Grows to 45 feet x 35 feet.

### **EMERALD QUEEN MAPLE 2" \$279 2.5" \$329 3" 409.**

Ascending branches with a oval to rounded outline. Rapid grower. Dark green leaves in summer turning yellow/red in fall. Grows 50 feet x 40 feet.

### **SUNBURST HONEY LOCUST 2" \$269 2.5" 339. 3" 479**

Tree is vase shaped spreading to 40 feet. Fine textured small leaflets, yellow in fall. Grows to 40 feet.

### **SKYLINE HONEY LOCUST 2" \$269 2.5" \$339**

Pyramidal shape with central leader. Medium green compound leaf. Bright yellow fall Color. Grows to 50 feet.

### **GOLDEN WEEPING WILLOW 2" \$259 2.5" \$319**

Rounded weeping shape. Narrow leaves with silvery undersides. Massive trunk and limbs with slender weeping golden barked twigs. Golden fall leaves. Fast growing 50 to 70 feet.

### **REDMOND LINDEN 2" \$299 2.5" \$339 3" \$429**

Fast growing tree with a pyramidal shape. Light green foliage turning to a yellowish Color in the fall. Grows 35 feet to 25 feet.
