**PARADE TIME** July 1, 2011. Line up 5:30 p.m. Parade steps off promptly at 6:30 p.m.

**LINE OF MARCH** 95th St. from Pulaski Avenue, east to 95th St. and **Richmond**, north on **Richmond** to 91st Street, where the parade will disband. To reach Kedzie Avenue go west on 91st St. To reach Western Avenue, turn east on 91st St. If you wish, you may continue north on **Richmond** Ave. to reach 87th Street.

## ALL UNITS PARADE LINE-UP NUMBERS

**Numbers 1 thru 20** will line up on the WEST SIDE of Harding Ave., starting on the 9500 block and stretching south to the 9800 block.

**Numbers 21 thru 40** will line up on the EAST SIDE of Harding Ave., starting on the 9500 block and stretching south to the 9800 block.

**Numbers 41 thru 60** will line up on the WEST SIDE of Springfield Ave., starting on the 9500 block and stretching south to the 9800 block.

**Numbers 61 thru 80** will line up on the EAST SIDE of Springfield Ave., starting on the 9500 block and stretching south to the 9800 block.

**Numbers 81 thru 100** will line up on the WEST SIDE of Avers Ave., starting on the 9500 block and stretching south to the 9800 block.

**Numbers 101 thru 120** will line up on the EAST SIDE of Avers Ave., starting on the 9500 block and stretching south to the 9800 block.

*Enter from 98th St. or 99th St. and proceed north on street until you reach assigned number.*

*Please **DO NOT** throw candy or other items from moving vehicles.*

*No go carts or motor bikes will be allowed in parade unless operated by an adult over 21.*

## NOTE! NOTE!

If you want to be judged, you must visibly display your assigned number attached to the right side of your entry. Marching units must have the number carried by someone marching on the outer right side

## AWARDS

Judges will be stationed at various spots along the parade route. There will be no stopping for special routines at the reviewing stand, but rather the performance will be judged along the entire parade route. Trophies will be presented at the Evergreen Park Village Board meeting on Monday, July 18th at 7:30 p.m.
