The Evergreen Park police Department introduce youths 8-13 years with little or no golf experience to the game of golf. This week long clinic helps participants develop the basics of the golf swing and introduces them to the rules, etiquette and history of the game. Each clinic consists of twelve (16) hours of golf instruction and allows for police officers to have direct contact and interaction with the youths of the community. Each clinic is limited to 34 participants (17 boys & 17 girls).
