

**ORDINANCE NO. 6-2012**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-36, HOURS OF  
OPERATION, SECTION 3-56, LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS,  
AND SECTION, 3-58, FEES AND LIMITATIONS, OF  
CHAPTER 3, ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, OF THE EVERGREEN  
PARK MUNICIPAL CODE**

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Evergreen Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1**

That Section 3-36, Hours of operation, of Chapter 3, Alcoholic Liquor, of the Evergreen Park Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 3-36. Hours of operation.**

Licensed premises shall have the following hours of operation during which time alcoholic liquors may be sold, delivered, consumed or offered for sale:

- (1) Class A, Class AA, Class B, and Class D shall be open only from 7:00 a.m. in the morning to 2:00 a.m. the next morning on all days, except Sunday when the opening hour shall be 11:00 a.m. No package sales after 12:00 midnight.
- (2) Class C and Class CC shall be open only from 7:00 a.m. in the morning to 12:00 midnight on all days, except Sunday when the opening hour shall be 11:00 a.m.
- (3) Class E, Class F, Class G and Class H shall be open only from 7:00 a.m. in the morning to 12:00 midnight on all days, except Sunday when the opening hour shall be 11:00 a.m.

**Section 2**

That Section 3-56, License classifications, of Chapter 3, Alcoholic Liquor, of the Evergreen Park Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 3-56. License classifications.**

Licenses for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor shall be divided in the following classes:

- (1) *Class A, consumption on premises and package sales.* A Class A license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises and to sell package alcoholic liquors for consumption off the premises.

(1.1) *Class AA, consumption on premises and package sales (beer and wine only).* A Class AA license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises and to sell package beer and wine only for consumption off the premises.

(2) *Class B, consumption on premises.* A Class B license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises.

(3) *Class C, package sales.* A Class C license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of packages alcoholic liquors for consumption off the premises.

(3.1) *Class CC, package sales (beer and wine only).* A Class CC license entitles the licensee to make package sales of beer and wine only for consumption off the premises.

(4) *Class D, veterans consumption on premises.* A Class D license shall be issued only to a veterans organization organized and existing under a charter issued by a national organization incorporated by act of the Congress of the United States. A Class D license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises.

(5) *Class E, restaurant consumption on premises (beer and wine).* A Class E license shall be issued only to a restaurant having a seating capacity of 70 or more persons at individual tables or booths. A Class E license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of beer and wine only for consumption on the premises. No bar shall be permitted on the premises which can accommodate the seating or service of a patron from the bar. All sales of alcoholic liquor shall be made incidental to the sale of food purchased for and consumed on the licensed premise.

(6) *Class ENT, entertainment.* A Class ENT license may be issued in conjunction with a Class A, Class AA, Class B, Class D, Class E, Class F and Class G license under the terms and conditions established by the local liquor control commissioner. A Class ENT license entitles a licensee to provide entertainment under the terms and conditions of the license.

(7) *Class ENLT, entertainment limited.* A Class ENTL license may be issued in conjunction with any license under the terms and conditions established by the local liquor control commissioner on a daily basis. A Class ENTL license entitles a licensee to provide entertainment under the terms and conditions of the license.

(8) *Class F, restaurant consumption on premises.* A Class F license shall be issued only to a restaurant having a seating capacity of 100 or more persons at individual tables or booths. A Class F license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of alcoholic liquor only for consumption on the premises. No bar shall be permitted on the premises which can accommodate the seating or service of a patron from the bar. All sales of alcoholic liquor shall be made incidental to the sale of food purchased for and consumed on the licensed premise.

(9) *Class G, recreational club consumption on premises.* A Class G license shall be issued only to a health or recreational organization such as a tennis club. A Class G license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises. Sales of alcoholic liquor shall be made only to members and their guests, and for club banquets.

(10) *Class H, restaurant consumption on premises (specified alcohol).* A Class H license shall be issued only to a restaurant having a seating capacity of less than 100 persons at individual tables or booths. A Class H license entitles the licensee to make sales at retail of beer, wine, and not more than 5 specified alcoholic liquor drinks for consumption only on the premises. No bar shall be permitted on the premises which can accommodate the seating or service of a patron from the bar. All sales of alcoholic liquor shall be made incidental to the sale of food purchased for and consumed on the licensed premise.

**Section 3**

That Section 3-58, Fees and limitations, of Chapter 3, Alcoholic Liquor, of the Evergreen Park Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 3-58. Fees and limitations.**

(a) All licenses shall be on a calendar year basis. The license fee for each class of license and the maximum number of licenses in each class is as follows:

D	Veterans consumption on premises	1	200.00
E	Restaurant consumption on premises (beer and wine)	3	1,400.00
ENT	Entertainment		300.00
ENTL	Entertainment limited (per day)		10.00
F	Restaurant consumption on premises	1	1,400.00
G	Recreational club consumption on premises	1	1,400.00
H	Restaurant consumption on premises (specified alcohol)	1	1,600.00

(b) The number of licenses authorized in this section for all classes shall remain at the number set forth in this section; provided, however, that any license in such classes which is revoked, or not used because of the termination of liquor business on the premises for which the license has been issued, shall automatically reduce the number of authorized licenses of the particular class by the total number of revoked or not used licenses in the particular class and shall reduce the total number of licenses available.

**Section 4**

Unless otherwise provided, the penalty clause for this ordinance shall be Section 1-9 of the Evergreen Park Municipal Code.

**Section 5**

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

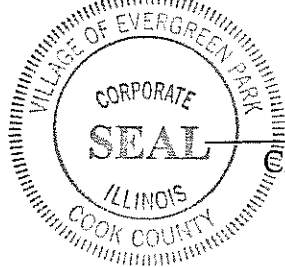
**Section 6**
